The undersigned affiant, after being duly sworn according to the law, states that Defendant John M Judkins

committed the offense of Domestic Assault

TCA 39-13-111 in the above county, on or about, 31 March, 2019.

Further, affiant makes oath that the essential facts constituting said offense, the sources of affiant's information and the reasons why his/her information is believable concerning said facts are as follows:

Officer Stogner responded to [redacted] Drive Mt. Juliet/ Wilson County Tennessee to investigate an assault. The officers investigation finds that John M Judkins was at the residence of his ex wife, [redacted] at approximately 5:00 AM a dispute began. The defendant was knocking on the bedroom door where [redacted] and her boyfriend [redacted] were sleeping. The defendant became hostile because the victims would not answer the door so he kicked the door open doing damage to the door and door casing; as he entered the room he was confronted by [redacted]. The defendant grabbed the victim by the throat impairing his ability to breath while shouting threats at the victim. [redacted] went to the aid of [redacted] but was shoved to the floor by the defendant. The officer noticed marks on [redacted]'s throat consistent with his description of the assault. The defendant actions placed both victims in fear for their life or safety.
